




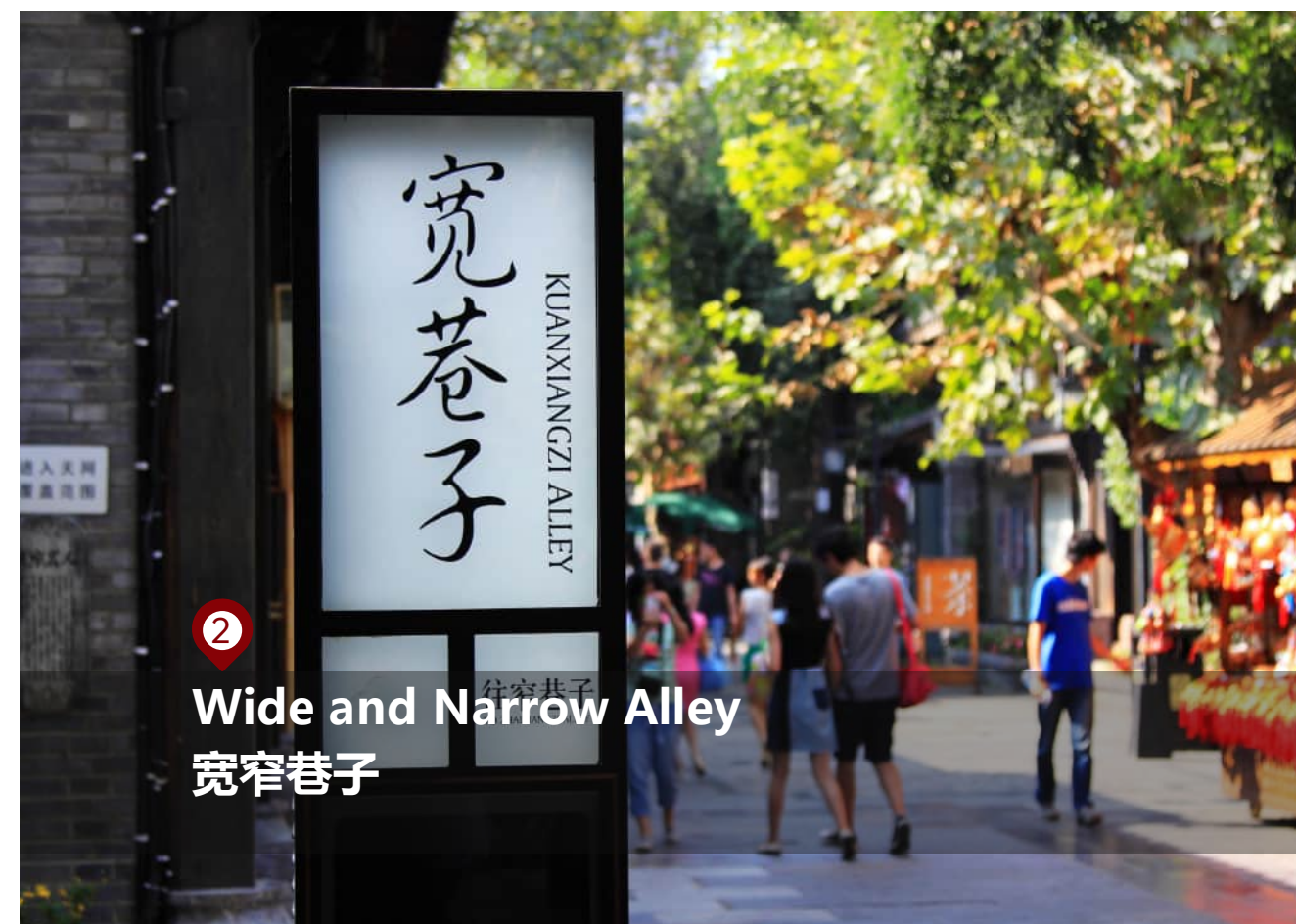

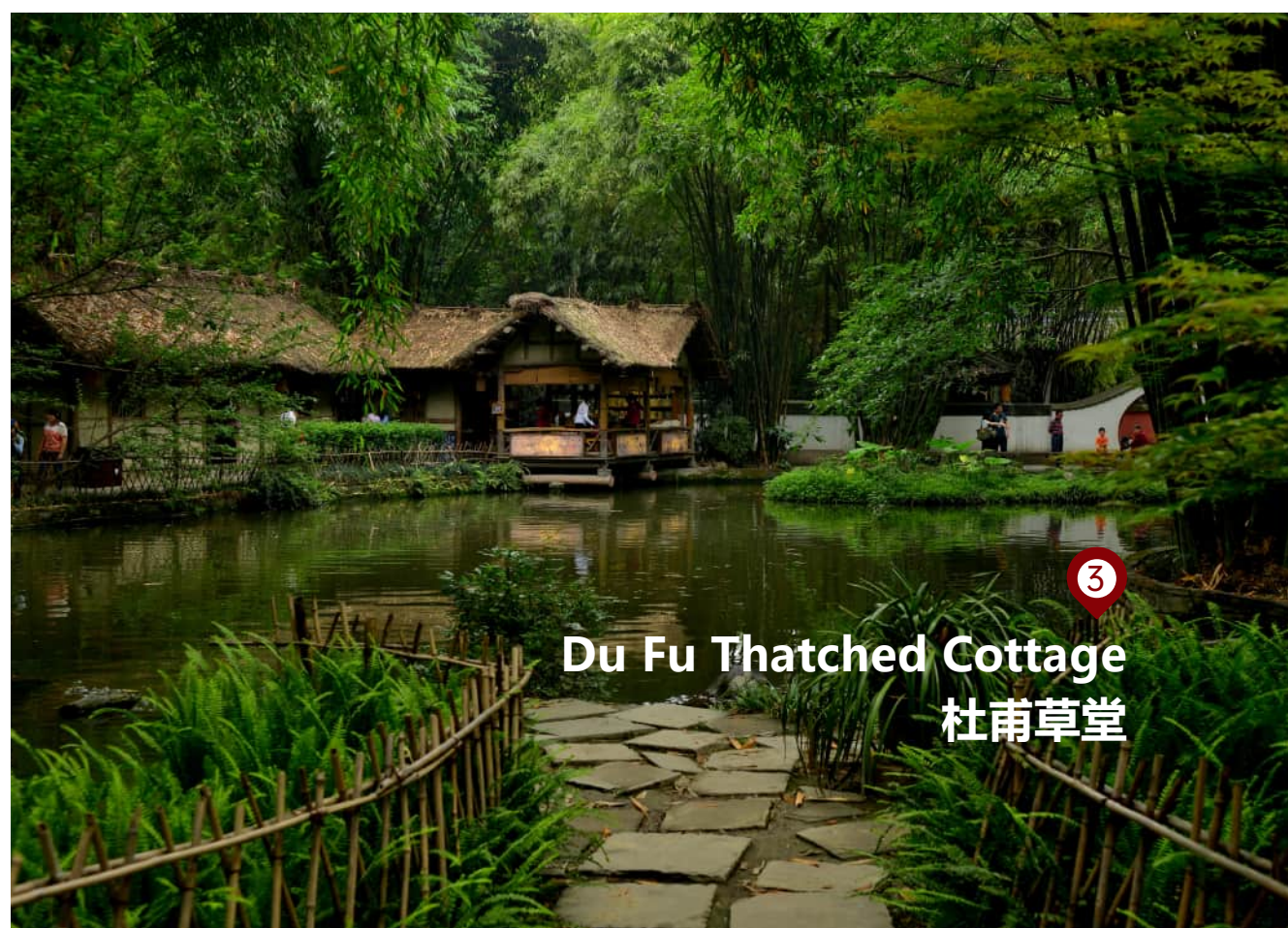

② Wide and Narrow Alley 宽窄巷子



Kuanzhai Alley is the only ancient street in Chengdu from the Qing Dynasty. ③ Du Fu Thatched Cottage 杜甫草堂



The former residence of Du Fu, a famous Tang Dynasty poet, when he lived in Chengdu. Du Fu lived here for nearly four years and wrote hundreds of poems, so this place is regarded as a "holy place" in the history of Chinese literature. Today's Du Fu Thatched Cottage has been restored many times during the Song, Yuan, Ming and Qing dynasties. There are pavilions and towering ancient trees in the garden.

4 Wuhou Temple 武侯祠



The Wuhou Temple in Chengdu is a temple dedicated to the heroes of Shu Han, such as Liu Bei and Zhuge Liang. It consists of Huiling, Han Zhao-lie Temple, and Wuhou Temple. There are 50 statues of Liu Bei, Zhuge Liang and other heroes of Shu Han enshrined in the temple.

Kuanzhai Alley is the only ancient street in Chengdu from the Qing Dynasty. - Bus: Take bus No. 1, 57, 82, 334, 335, 1126 and get off at Wuhouci Station; or take bus No. 8 or 21 and get off at Wuhouci East Street Station.
- Subway: Take subway Line 3 and get off at Gaoshengqiao Station, then walk 600-800 meters to Wuhouci Street.

5 Mount Qingcheng 青城山



Mount Qingcheng has been known as "the most secluded mountain in the world" since ancient times. It is divided into two parts: the front mountain and the back mountain. The front mountain is the main body of Mount Qingcheng, where Taoist culture and cultural relics are mostly concentrated. It is also known as "Mount Qingcheng" by tourists. The back mountain is famous for its natural scenery and is a good place for vacation and leisure.

Travel season

The weather in Qingcheng Mountain belongs to the subtropical warm and humid monsoon climate zone.

☉ Spring (March-May): The temperature changes greatly, and the climate is warm and humid.

☉ Summer (June-August): The temperature will gradually rise, with an average temperature of 21-30 degrees, and there will be more rain. Sometimes it will rain at night and the next day will be cool. The ultraviolet radiation is strong in this season, and the rain will come as soon as it comes.

☉ Autumn (September-November): The weather is clear and cool in autumn, with an average temperature of 14-20 degrees. The temperature will drop in October. The climate in Qingcheng Mountain is cool in autumn.

The terrain and environment of the scenic area make the temperature here slightly lower than outside.

☉ Winter (December-February): The temperature is low in winter, with an average temperature of 5-10 degrees. There will be occasional snowfall, but there will not be too deep snow.

Summer is the best season in Qingcheng Mountain. Qingcheng Mountain in this season is beautiful and has a cool climate. It is a good place to escape the summer heat.

Transportation

Qingcheng Mountain is located in the southwest of Dujiangyan City, Chengdu, about 68 kilometers east of Chengdu City.

① Chengdu-Qingcheng Mountain

● Bus:

1. Take a bus to Qingcheng Mountain at Chengdu Chadianzi Bus Station.
2. Take a bus to Qingcheng Mountain (back mountain) at Chengdu Xinnanmen Bus Station.

● Railway:

There are high-speed trains from Chengdu Xipu Station to Qingcheng Mountain.

More than ten trains depart every day, with a fare of 10 yuan per person and a journey of about 40 minutes. After exiting the station, take bus No. 101 or 102 to Qingcheng Mountain directly.

② Qingcheng Mountain Town-Qingcheng Mountain

● Bus: Qingcheng Mountain Town has bus No. 101 and 102 that go to Qingcheng Mountain, Dujiangyan, etc. Ask the driver if the terminal is Qingcheng Front Mountain and you can get on the bus. It takes about 10 yuan to take a taxi from Qingcheng Front Mountain to Back Mountain.



Dujiangyan is surrounded by beautiful scenery and numerous cultural relics, including Fulong Temple, Erwang Temple, Anlan Cable Bridge, Yulei Pass, Lidui Park, etc. It is the oldest and only remaining large-scale water conservancy project in the world that features damless water diversion.

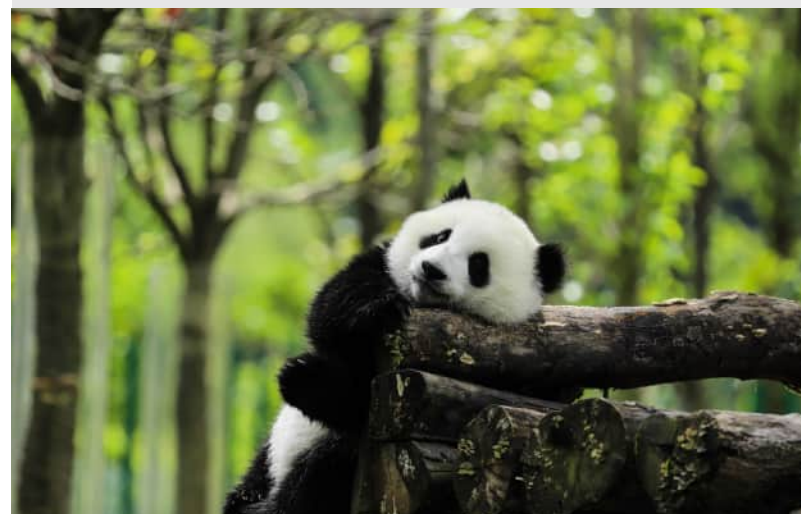

7 Giant Panda Breeding Research Base 大熊猫繁育基地



The Giant Panda Breeding Research Institute completely simulates the wild living environment of giant pandas, with lakes, streams, bamboo forests, lawns, etc., and has more than 100 giant pandas. There is a Giant Panda Museum near the gate. You can send postcards with panda stamps at the Panda Country Post Office, and you can also watch records about giant pandas in the cinema.

You can take Metro Line 3 to Panda Avenue Station and then take the scenic area through bus to the site, or take bus No. 87, 198, or 655 and get off at Panda Base Station and walk to the site.

8 Jiuzhaigou Valley 九寨沟



Jiuzhaigou is located in Jiuzhaigou County, Aba Prefecture. The valley is home to snow-capped peaks, dense forests, colorful pools and shallows, and crystal clear streams flowing between the forests and shallows.

Together with the Tibetan wooden buildings, prayer flags and the unique traditional customs of the Tibetan and Qiang ethnic groups, Jiuzhaigou is known as a "beautiful fairy tale world."

Travel season

☉ Spring (April-May): All things welcome spring, shake off the snow, and Jiuzhaigou slowly enters spring. Although the water volume is not abundant in this season, the warm spring light awakens the tender green forests and wild flowers on the roadside, which is full of vitality.

☉ Summer (June-August): Coolness is undoubtedly the best reason for people to come to Jiuzhaigou. Jiuzhaigou is cool and pleasant, with dense vegetation and abundant water. Summer is also the best time to understand "no water after returning from Jiuzhaigou".

☉ Autumn (September-October): The colorful autumn forests are the main attraction of this season. God overturned the palette in Jiuzhaigou, and every fallen leaf is a landscape.

☉ Winter (November-March of the following year): This season is the off-season for Jiuzhaigou tourism. If you come to the entrance of Jiuzhaigou at this time, you will see a large number of shops closed. However, Jiuzhaigou in the ice and snow also has another winter charm, and the ticket price in the off-season is much cheaper than that in the peak season.

Jiuzhaigou has its own charm in each season: charming spring, gorgeous summer, rich autumn and strange winter.

The best time to visit is in late October, when the mountains and forests are colorful and reflected in the lake, which is beautiful and attracts many tourists. Some tourists prefer the quiet winter, when the snowy scenery is frozen and there are few people.

Transportation

● Passenger transport:

① There are buses from Chengdu Xinnanmen Station to Jiuzhaigou Scenic Area, and the journey time is about 10 hours;

② Chengdu Chadianzi Bus Station has direct buses to Jiuzhaigou Scenic Area, and the journey time is about 10 hours.

● High-speed rail:

Depart from Chengdu East Station, there are many buses, you can choose freely according to your personal schedule, and the ride time is about 1.5 hours. After getting off the bus, take the unified bus (shuttle bus) near the high-speed rail station to Jiuzhaigou Entrance, and the bus ride time is 1 hour

9 Bipenggou 毕棚沟



Bipenggou is connected to Wolong Nature Reserve in the east and Siguniang Mountain Scenic Area in the south; together with Siguniang Mountain and Wolong, it forms the "Giant Panda Corridor World Heritage Site". It is a large-scale original ecological tourism scenic spot integrating original ecological landscape exposition, mountaineering and crossing, polar exploration, skiing and skating, and leisure and vacation.

⦿ The scenery of Bipenggou in autumn is absolutely beautiful, with red leaves, clear water and snow-capped mountains forming a stunning scene. However, there are many tourists, so travel during the National Day holiday needs to be planned in advance.

Transportation

● Car:

Take the bus from Chengdu Chadianzi Station to Li County, and then share a car from Li County to Bipenggou after arriving.

● Transportation within the scenic area:

Transfer to the scenic area bus at the scenic area ticket center to enter the scenic area and go to the Shanghaizi Reception Center; from the Shanghaizi Reception Center to the scenic spots along the way to Panyang Lake, you can choose to take the scenic area battery car or walk (the whole journey is about 9 kilometers).

5 Leshan Giant Buddha 乐山大佛



The Leshan Giant Buddha is located in Leshan City, on the rock wall of Qixia Peak of Lingyun Mountain at the confluence of the Minjiang River, Qingyi River and Dadu River. It is also known as the Lingyun Giant Buddha and has been approved by UNESCO as a "World Cultural and Natural Heritage".

It is a seated Maitreya Buddha and a masterpiece of cliff carving art from the Tang Dynasty.

☉ Spring and autumn are the best seasons to travel to Leshan.

Transportation

● Bus:

Take bus No. 601, k1, 302, 3 and get off at Leshan Giant Buddha Station

● By boat:

① Take the ferry from Leshan Port to the Giant Buddha

② Take a cruise ship at the pier in the scenic area to view the Leshan Giant Buddha. The tour time is about 15 minutes. Since there is no pier, the boat will not dock, and tourists can only enjoy the Leshan Giant Buddha on the boat

Eating

Chengdu, as a UNESCO-certified "City of Gourmet Food", is famous for its rich and diverse food culture and unique spicy flavor. Chengdu cuisine is not only a treat for the taste buds, but also a reflection of the city's lifestyle.

Main Cuisine

◆ Hot Pot 火锅

Chengdu hotpot is famous for its unique spicy and fragrant flavor. The ingredients are rich and varied. The hotpot base is carefully stir-fried with chili peppers, peppercorns, ginger, garlic, spices, etc. It is spicy but not dry, and numbing but not bitter.



◆ Chuan Chuan Xiang 串串香

Chuan Chuan Xiang is a variation of hot pot, with various ingredients skewered on bamboo sticks, and customers can choose according to their preferences. There are also many choices for the base of the pot, such as spicy and clear soup, and after cooking, it is dipped in special seasonings and eaten.



◆ Mao Cai 冒菜

Maocai is known as "a hot pot for one person". Customers choose their favorite ingredients and let the store cook them. Then add the prepared soup, seasonings and red oil. The soup of Maocai is rich and spicy.



Specialty Snacks

◆ Spicy Rabbit Head 麻辣兔头

Selected fresh rabbit heads are soaked in secret brine and coated with bright red spicy seasoning. Every bite is full of rich Sichuan flavor. Gently break it open, the tender meat and spicy juice interweave on the tip of the tongue, and the layers of numbing, spicy, fresh and fragrant are progressive, making people unable to stop.



◆ Bearing Surface 担担面

The noodles are smooth and thin, topped with minced meat, crushed peanuts, bean sprouts and red oil, giving it a spicy and fresh taste.



◆ Chao Shou 抄手

The skin is thin and the filling is rich. The soup is delicious. There are many flavors such as red oil and clear soup to meet the needs of different diners.



◆ Sugar-coated Fruit 糖油果子

It is fried with glutinous rice, brown sugar and sesame. It is bright yellow in color, crispy on the outside and glutinous on the inside, sweet and delicious.



◆ Ice Powder 冰粉

It is made of ice powder seeds and is transparent. When added with ingredients, it tastes cool, smooth, sweet and delicious.

● Sichuan Opera Face Changing 川剧变脸

Sichuan Opera face-changing is a treasure of Sichuan's traditional culture. The actors change their facial makeup in an instant, which is mysterious and very entertaining.



● Gaiwan Tea 盖碗茶

Chengdu's teahouse culture has a long history. Drinking tea, listening to storytelling, and watching Sichuan opera are part of the local people's leisure life.



● Mahjong 麻将

Mahjong is one of the traditional Chinese board games, especially in Sichuan, where the mahjong culture is deeply rooted in the hearts of the people. In Chengdu, you can experience this fun and challenging mahjong culture in teahouses, families, friends gatherings and other occasions.



● Taoist Culture 道教文化

Qingcheng Mountain is one of the birthplaces of Taoism. Visitors can visit Taoist temples, experience Taoist culture, and feel the tranquility and nature.

● Eastern Suburbs Memory 东郊记忆

Walking on the streets of Dongjiao Memory, it feels like traveling through a time tunnel. The old-fashioned buildings with red bricks and black tiles are mottled by the years, but they are rejuvenated with the creative decoration of the new era.
