Sights

The Bund 外滩



The Bund is located on the bank of the Huangpu River. It is about 1.5 kilometers long and is a symbol of Shanghai. The buildings of different styles stand tall, recreating the style of the "Wall Street of the Far East". The diverse architectural styles are important historical sites and representative buildings. You can take a boat trip on the river at night to enjoy the bustling city view.

Located in Shanghai's Pudong New Area, Shanghai Disney Resort is the first Disney resort in mainland China. It has classic attractions such as a large Disney castle, a pirate theme park, and an extra-long parade route,

allowing visitors to immerse themselves in the magical charm of fairy tales.

The Oriental Pearl Tower is adjacent to the Huangpu River and across the river from the Bund. It is a landmark cultural landscape in Shanghai and one of the first 5A-level scenic spots in China. It is 468 meters high, with 11 spheres connected in series. The 267-meter revolving restaurant offers a night view, and the 259-meter suspended gallery overlooks the river and Lujiazui.

④ Shanghai Science and Technology Museum 上海科技馆



The Shanghai Science and Technology Museum is the largest science education center in Shanghai. It uses modern equipment to help people understand natural science in all aspects. There are five main exhibition halls, seven exhibition areas and four cinemas in the museum. The exhibits are rich, including wild animal specimens, robot performances, etc. It is rich in knowledge and highly interactive, making it a great choice for family trips.

⑤ Yu Garden 豫园



Yu Garden is located in the northeast of Shanghai Yu Garden Tourism and Commercial Zone, adjacent to the City God Temple and the Tourism Mall. It is a world-famous Jiangnan classical garden and became a national key cultural relic protection unit in 1982.

It was first built in the Ming Dynasty, covers an area of about 2 hectares, and fully displays the style of Ming and Qing Jiangnan gardens. It retains many historical sites and is highly praised by the ancients..

⑥ Nanjing Road Pedestrian Street 南京路步行街



Nanjing Road Pedestrian Street is one of the top ten famous pedestrian streets in China and the earliest commercial street after Shanghai opened its port. It is a shopping destination with a wide range of products, full of literary and fashionable atmosphere, creative sculptures, chairs for rest, and trams running around, showing the charm of old Shanghai.

⑦ Jing'an Temple 静安寺



Jing'an Temple is a famous ancient temple in Shanghai. Its architectural style is a fusion of Tibetan style. The 15-ton silver Buddha in the main hall is solemn.

The temple includes the main buildings such as the mountain gate, and the golden roof is eye-catching. This place is very popular. There are ceremonies on the birthdays and anniversaries of the Bodhisattva. There is also a three-day temple fair on the eighth day of the fourth lunar month.

⑧ Zhujiajiao Ancient Town 朱家角古镇



Zhujiajiao Ancient Town is located in Qingpu District, Shanghai, close to Dianshan Lake. It is a typical Jiangnan water town. The town is rich in attractions, snacks and shops, and is the first choice for ancient towns around Shanghai. The ancient town is not big and is suitable for walking tours. The Zhuxi Garden and the Humanities and Arts Museum at the entrance each have their own characteristics.

Eating

Shanghai is a city with a variety of styles. In terms of food, Shanghainese cuisine is rich in oil and sauce, such as the braised pork with a mixture of sweet and salty flavors that melts in your mouth; exquisite snacks are endless, such as the delicious soup dumplings and the crispy and juicy pan-fried dumplings. Here, Chinese and Western cultures blend together,

and Shanghai-style Western cuisine is unique. Shanghainese people are warm and hospitable, and the Shikumen houses are close to neighbors. There are also traditional activities such as dragon and lion dances, which fully demonstrate the unique local customs and people.

◆ Braised Pork 红烧肉

A classic representative of Shanghainese cuisine, it is made by slow-cooking pork belly with rice wine, soy sauce, etc. It is bright red in color, fat but not greasy, and has a sweet and salty taste that melts in your mouth.



◆ Fried Shrimp 油爆虾

The main ingredient is river shrimp, which is quickly fried over high heat and then quickly stir-fried with soy sauce, sugar, rice wine and other seasonings. The shrimp shell is crispy and the meat is tender, the sauce is sweet and fresh, and the shrimp brain is fat and can be eaten with the shell.



◆ Shanghai Steamed Dumplings 上海小笼包

Shanghai Xiaolongbao has thin skin and lots of soup, with flower-like wrinkles and sweet meat filling. When eating, first bite through the skin and sip the soup, then dip it in shredded ginger and vinegar to relieve the greasiness.



◆ Pan-fried buns 生煎馒头

The semi-fermented dough is fried until golden and crispy, with juicy meat filling and sprinkled with sesame and chives. There are many styles, such as Da Hu Chun's thick skin without juice and Xiao Yang Sheng Jian's thin skin with juiciness.



◆ Pork Ribs and Rice Cake 排骨年糕

Pork ribs and rice cakes, the pork ribs are coated with flour and fried until crispy, paired with soft and glutinous rice cakes, and then topped with sweet noodle sauce and spicy soy sauce. Sweet, spicy, crispy and tender, it is a classic Shanghai carbohydrate combination.



◆ Scallion Oil Noodles 葱油拌面

The noodles are mixed with scallion oil and soy sauce, and can be sprinkled with dried shrimps to enhance the flavor. The noodles absorb the aroma of the scallion oil and have a chewy texture. It is simple but addictive.



◆ Crab Shell Yellow 蟹壳黄

Shanghai Crab Shell Yellow is shaped like a crab shell, with a golden and crispy shell and sprinkled with white sesame seeds. The filling is both sweet and salty, with sweet bean paste and jujube paste, and salty with fresh meat and scallion oil. When you bite it, the crisp sound is accompanied by the fragrance.



◆ Shanghai Smoked Fish 上海熏鱼

Shanghai smoked fish is a representative traditional cold dish in Shanghai, carrying the unique flavor and nostalgia of old Shanghai. Select fresh grass carp, cut into thick slices, and deep-fry at high temperature until the shell is golden and crispy, locking the freshness of the fish meat. Then, the fried fish slices are dipped in a secret marinade carefully made of soy sauce, rock sugar, star anise, cinnamon, etc., so that it can fully absorb the rich sauce flavor. The finished product is a mixture of salty and sweet, crispy on the outside and tender on the inside, and is an indispensable delicacy on the table of Shanghai people.



◆ Eight Treasure Rice Pudding 八宝饭

Eight Treasure Rice Pudding is a traditional Shanghai delicacy. It is based on high-quality glutinous rice and is embedded with eight kinds of ingredients such as red dates, longans, walnuts, and red bean paste. After being steamed, the rice grains are soft, sweet, and melt in your mouth. The surface is decorated with red and green preserved fruits, and the color is bright and attractive. The soft and sticky glutinous rice and the sweet fillings blend with each other, with a rich taste that is sweet but not greasy. It is not only the "finale dessert" on the New Year's Eve dinner table, but also often appears in festive banquets, implying a happy reunion and good luck.



◆ Cream Square 奶油小方

Cream square is a classic Shanghai dessert, carrying the sweet memories of generations of Shanghai people. It is based on a soft and dense sponge cake, sandwiched with light and silky animal cream, and sprinkled with a layer of fine white sugar on the top. The milky white and yellow are alternating, and the shape is simple but mouth-watering. When you eat it, the softness of the cake and the sweetness of the cream blend on the tip of your tongue. It is sweet but not greasy, and has a rich taste. It is the signature food of Ruby Western Pastry and the most gentle nostalgic taste in the streets and alleys of old Shanghai.
